

U.S. Faces Government Shutdown

- A U.S. federal government shutdown began following Congress's failure to pass appropriations bills or a continuing resolution for FY2026. Deadlocks largely revolve around ACA subsidies, which are set to expire at the end of the calendar year.
- About 900,000 federal workers are furloughed, while 700,000 essential employees work without immediate pay. Similarly, many government contractors face work stoppages and delays in funding until the shutdown is resolved.



New Tensions Arise in Europe & Caribbean

- On September 10, approximately 20 Russian UAVs flew deep into Polish airspace; some were shot down by NATO jets, while others crashed. On September 19, three armed MiG-31 fighters turned off transponders and flew over Estonian airspace for 12 minutes. These incursions were likely intended to sow division within NATO and gather intelligence.
- The US began building up its presence in the Caribbean amid heightened tensions with Venezuela. The U.S. has amassed thousands of Marines, deployed warships, and conducted airstrikes on alleged drug smuggling vessels in the region.



M&A Activity Strongest Since 2021


- Global year-to-date M&A activity has reached nearly \$3.1T, up 35% over the same period last year and the strongest first three quarters since 2021.
- Deal activity has been predominantly driven by significant large-cap transactions, with a total of 47 deals valued at over \$10B. This marks the highest number of such deals recorded since LSEG began tracking this data over four decades ago.




ByteDance Nears Deal to Sell TikTok

- Following diplomatic talks in Spain, a framework agreement was announced between the Trump administration and China regarding the sale of TikTok. According to the agreement, a new U.S. company will be formed and valued at approximately \$14 billion. ByteDance will be required to retain a stake of less than 20% in this new entity.
- Ongoing concerns about data privacy and the CCP's influence on Western opinion regarding key issues have prompted
 calls from across the political spectrum for increased regulations on the popular application.

- Ukraine ramped up long range strikes against Russian critical infrastructure in Q3 2025, targeting ammunition plants, oil refineries, and supply depots. The strikes have reportedly led to gas shortages, long lines at the pump, and fuel rationing across certain Russian regions. The most recent attacks have achieved greater success than previous efforts by utilizing a larger number of drones against a single target to overwhelm counter-unmanned aerial systems (C-UAS), which are already stretched thin due to frontline requirements.
- On September 9, Israel conducted an airstrike in Doha, the capital of Qatar (designated a major non-NATO ally by the U.S. and housing U.S. forces at Al Udeid airbase), killing several senior Hamas officials who had been involved in negotiations over a ceasefire in Gaza and the release of Israeli hostages. U.S. President Trump responded by issuing an executive order that elevated U.S. security guarantees for Qatar.
- In September, the U.S. Army awarded RTX a ~\$5B contract to produce Coyote missiles and associated Ku-band Radio Frequency Systems (KuRFS). The Coyote is a low-cost, radar-steered missile designed for C-UAS use cases. The missile and its radar are also components of the U.S. Army's LIDS (Low, slow, small, unmanned aircraft Integrated Defeat System) C-UAS solution, which integrates multiple technologies to provide a layered defense against Group 1-3 small UAS. The new contract represents a significant expansion of the Coyote program, which has so far equipped three Army divisions with the C-UAS capability, underscoring the demand for cost-effective solutions to counter the growing and evolving threat posed by small UAVs.




Market Commentary

- The S&P 500, up 17.3% in the TTM, remained steady in Q3 2025 as the Fed lowered rates by 25 basis points in September, marking the first rate cut of 2025. The cut comes amidst a cooling job market, which added an average of 29,000 new jobs in the three months ending in August, versus an average of 99,000 for the three months ending in May 2025. Inflation remained persistent around 3% year-over-year, although tariff passthrough costs have been less severe than expected.
- TMG's Defense Systems index has nearly doubled over the TTM as recent conflicts, especially the war in Ukraine, have demonstrated the importance of sensor and drone technologies, driving demand for products from companies like Kratos (+268% in the TTM). Kratos recently partnered with GE Aerospace to develop engines for the Air Force's Collaborative Combat Aircraft (CCA), which, although in the early stages of development, is planned to become an autonomous and attritable wingman to advanced fighter platforms like the F-35 and F-47.

Q3 M&A REPORT

- In September 2025, CISA issued Emergency Directive 25-03 following the active exploitation of critical flaws in Cisco ASA and Firepower devices. Federal agencies were instructed to immediately identify and patch affected systems to prevent remote compromise. The directive reflects heightened federal urgency around vulnerability management and the modernization of perimeter defenses
- A breach exploiting a Citrix zero-day exposed sensitive employee data from FEMA and U.S. Customs and Border Protection. The incident highlighted persistent cybersecurity weaknesses across federal networks and the growing interconnected risks between civilian and critical infrastructure systems
- In September 2025, a gunman opened fire on a Dallas ICE facility, killing two detainees and injuring another before dying by suicide.
 Investigators identified an anti-ICE motive, prompting DHS to strengthen security measures and active-threat protocols across federal sites.












EBITDA VALUATION MULTIPLES

- The bipartisan Water Infrastructure Resilience and Sustainability Act of 2025 has been introduced in the U.S. House to fund upgrades within drinking water, wastewater, and stormwater systems. The bill would provide greater resiliency to threats ranging from cyber attacks to extreme weather and would reauthorize three existing resilience programs at their current funding levels: Drinking Water System Infrastructure Resilience & Sustainability Program (\$25M annually), Midsize & Large Drinking Water System Infrastructure Resilience & Sustainability Program (\$50M annually), and the Clean Water Infrastructure Resiliency & Sustainability Program (\$25M annually).
- A study conducted by the University of Idaho estimates that the state of Idaho needs over \$1B in infrastructure work this year to address shortfalls in drinking and wastewater systems. The infrastructure challenges stem from aging systems, rapid population growth, and stricter regulatory pressures. In 2023, over half of Idaho's wastewater treatment plants reported violations of the federal Clean Water Act.












EBITDA VALUATION MULTIPLES1

- The Indian government approved a comprehensive financing initiative aimed at positioning its shipbuilding industry to rank among the top five globally. This initiative encompasses three financial packages, including approximately \$2.8B dedicated to financing shipbuilding, \$2.3B allocated for a maritime development fund, and a further \$2.25B intended to enhance domestic shipbuilding capacity to 4.5 million gross tons. Furthermore, a "Shipbreaking Credit Note scheme" has been introduced to promote ship recycling in India, offering credits equivalent to around 40% of a ship's scrap value, which can be utilized for the construction of new vessels.
- French authorities have seized the tanker *Boracay*, linked to the Russian "Shadow Fleet," in the Atlantic. This follows Danish investigations into shadow fleet tankers related to a recent drone attack. Boracay is known for using fake identities to transport Russian crude and is one of three vessels potentially involved in a UAV incident that closed Copenhagen's airport in September.


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
